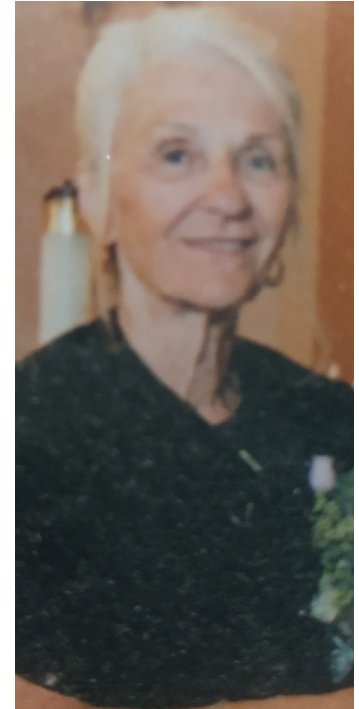


**Resident of the Month: Patricia Rehmann**
